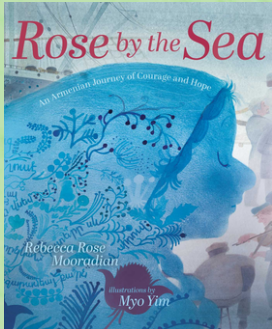

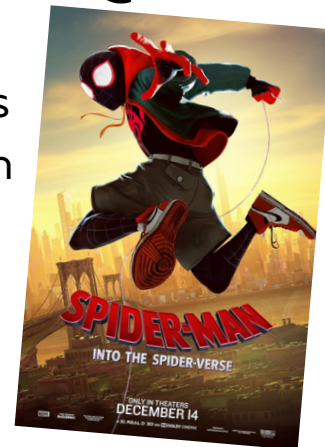

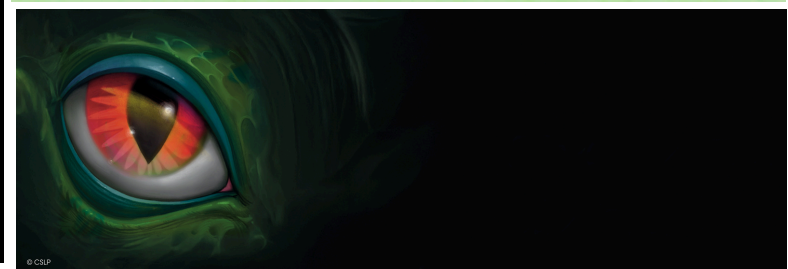
Jaelyn is the media girl! She is over all the library social medias and updates the website. She has also reently taken on the role of teen programmer.

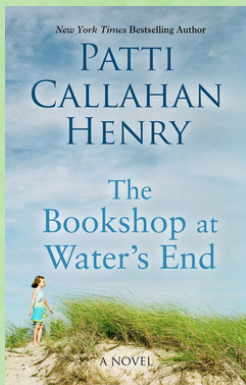
